(Genesis 12-22)

Q: Who did God promise to give so many children and grandchildren to that he wouldn't be able to count them all? A: Abraham

Q: Who did God say would be blessed by Abraham's special family? A: The whole world.

Q: Why did it seem impossible for God to give Abraham and his wife Sarah children? A: They were too old. Abraham was 99 years old and Sarah was 90 years old!

Q: Did God give them a child like He promised? A: Yes! When God says something, it's as good as done.

Q: What did Abraham and Sarah name their son? A: Isaac

Q: What does the name Isaac mean? A: Son of laughter

Q: How did God test Abraham's trust? A: God asked Abraham to give his only son Isaac as a sacrifice to Him.

Q: True or False: Abraham did everything God said even though he didn't understand why. A: True. Abraham knew God loved him so he trusted and obeyed God.

Q: What did God provide just in time to die so Isaac didn't have to? A: A ram.
